Tentative Schedule

We have created this schedule and what the days would look like. We are open to other suggestions.

Day 1

Boats will meet and check in at Big Majors Anchorage, located just north of Staniel Cay. (A large, safe and secure anchorage)

5:30 Meet & Greet Beach Party - with hors d'oeuvres , wine & beer and sodas.

Don't forget to feed the wild swimming pigs!

Day 2

Spend the day exploring the Big Majors Area. Snorkel famous Thunderball Cave.

Explore Staniel Cay – hike around the quaint town or rent a golf cart to see it all.

Kayak, swim, or a dive trip can be arranged with Staniel Cay Divers.

Dinner Day 2 hosted by Staniel Cay Yacht Club.

Day 3 & 4

Move to Compass Cay Marina area for 2 nights. It will be your choice to anchor out or take a slip at the Marina.

This is a fantastic Cay to explore! Beautiful beaches, great hiking, kayaking, snorkel trip to Rocky Dundas Caves. Hike or dinghy to “Rachels’ Bubble Bath” natural pool, and explore Pipe Creek by dingy.

Swim with Tucker’s pet Nurse Sharks at the dock.

Cocktails and Pot Luck Dinner at Compass Cay Marina.



Day 5

We will move to Sampson Cay Marina.

Once again it will be your choice to anchor out or take a Marina Slip.

This is a beautiful area to spend the day exploring and or just relaxing and enjoying the beauty of the Bahamas.

Final Rendezvous Group Dinner - Meet at the Sampson Cay Bar, for cocktails and dinner hosted by Sampson Cay Marina.
