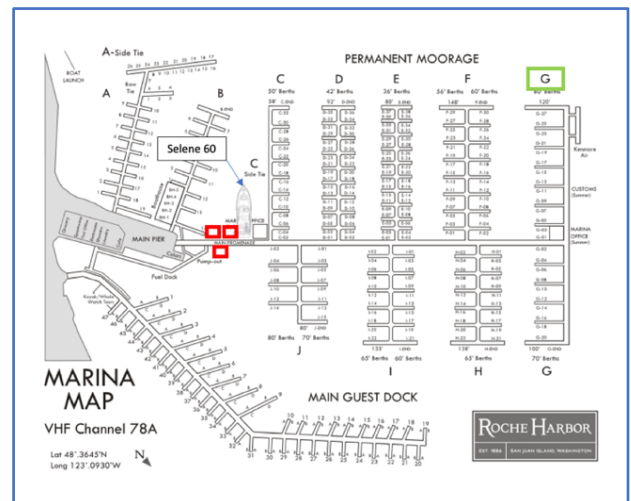
After dinner on Thursday, an impromptu music Jam Session is tentatively being planned. Please indicate your interest in attending on the registration form.
